  - a. Added: PBIS will be holding 3 community/family nights during this school year to give opportunities to get more involved and connected
- 3. Secretary's Report
  - a. N/A to this meeting as the minutes were from the previous year last meeting's discussion was focused on Jag Jog results and EOY events.
- 4. Treasurer's Report Bonnie Vangalis
  - a. Going into this school year, PFC has the following starting balances in the two PFC accounts: \$20,767 in Jag Jog account; \$10,013 in Regular account = \$30,780 total
  - b. Need discussion on how to spend the funds Ms. Hucek will poll the faculty for some ideas on how we can best use the funds to benefit the student body.
    - i. All agreed that PFC should clearly communicate our mission (security, family engagement, form and function, etc.) Discussion tabled until Ms. Hucek reports back on staff feedback.
  - c. Approximately \$6,000 Jag Jog funds are dedicated to the window screening (invoice hasn't been paid)
  - d. Conservative projected <u>net</u> income for 23/24 school year is \$5k adding to an already robust account balance need to spend about \$20K this year.
  - e. PFC assists with food for faculty during conferences, offsetting field trip costs, busses for kids to go to off campus events, and other funds requests which are agreed upon by the PFC
  - f. Funds Request none at this time
