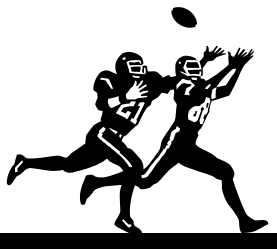

Speaker Highlights

STEVE KLISTER & MATT BINSFELD *Wrightstown High School*



Steve Klister and Matt Binsfeld are Co-Head Coaches at Wrightstown High School. The Tigers have been playoff participants for 17 consecutive years and are coming off their second Div. 5 State Championship in six years. Coach Klister has recently finished his 14th year as Co-Head



Coach and Coach Binsfeld completed his 1st year. The full-house T-offense and smash mouth football are trademarks of the Wrightstown football program.

DAVE HINKENS *Appleton Xavier High School*



Dave Hinkens is the head football coach at Appleton Xavier where he has coached the Hawks since 2001. Under his leadership the Hawk's overall record stands at 92-29 and includes six Conference Championships and two level 4 playoff victories in 2004 and 2010. At this clinic Hinkens will provide an overview on how Xavier uses Hudl both in and out-of-season.

BRIAN BORLAND *UW-Whitewater*



Brian Borland entered the position of defensive coordinator on the UW-Whitewater football staff in 2002. Borland had coached the defensive backs in his previous eight years at UW-W. Borland earned Wisconsin Collegiate Assistant Coach of the Year honors from WFCIA in 2004, and in 2009 led the Warhawks to the fourth best scoring defense in Division III.

TOM TOURTILLOTT *Merrill High School*



Tom Tourtillot began his football coaching career at South Milwaukee High School in 1991 and then moved to Merrill High School where he has been coaching since 1998. He has been the Head Coach since 2005 and his accomplishments include Merrill's 2009 team winning their first Conference Championship in 30 years, and winning the first playoff game in school history.

Tourtillot also coached the defensive line in the 2011 WFCIA All Star Game.

JED KENNEDY *Kenosha Bradford High School*



Jed Kennedy has been the head football coach at Kenosha Bradford for 5 years. His Red Devils career record is 40-9 and includes 3 trips to the quarterfinals and reaching the state semi-finals in 2010, and winning the SEC conference in 2009. Other coaching experience for Kennedy includes previous positions at MacArthur High in Illinois, Lake Brantley High in Florida, and UW-River Falls.

JACK BATTEN *West DePere High School*



Jack Batten has been coaching in the Green Bay area for 23 years, most recently at West DePere High as the defensive coordinator for the last 6 years. While coaching at West DePere, the Phantoms have won 6 consecutive conference championships with a conference record of 52-2 and overall record of 69-6. They've made 3 consecutive trips to Madison with two State Championships at the Division 3 level. West DePere also led the conference in the fewest yards/points for the past 5 years.

BEN HERBERT *University of Wisconsin*



After graduating from UWM in 2002, Ben Herbert joined the Badger strength and conditioning staff as an intern under John Dettmann. Upon completion of his internship, in 2003 he was promoted to assistant strength and conditioning coach. In 2009 Herbert was named the head strength and conditioning coach for the Badgers, where his primary responsibilities include coordinating all aspects of sports conditioning for the UW football team. Herbert played and lettered 4 years for the Badgers and was a 2-year starter on the defensive line under Coach John Palermo. During his tenure, he participated in two Rose Bowl championships and a Sun Bowl victory.
