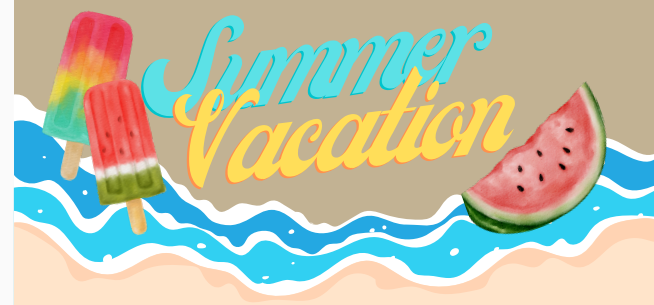

TEACHER ASSIGNMENTS FOR 24-25 SCHOOL YEAR

Teacher assignments for the 24-25 school year will be available on Parent PowerSchool Accounts in mid-August. When available in PowerSchool, a reminder email with instructions will be sent to email addresses we have on record for your student(s). Please keep your email address(es) current in your PowerSchool Parent Account so you do not miss this important information.

STUDENT MEDICATION PICK UP

Parents/Guardians please stop in the Valley View office to pick up any remaining medication kept in the office for your child/children by June 5, 2024. Medication must be transported by an adult and can not be sent home with students. If prescription and non-prescription medicines, including inhalers, are not picked up they will be disposed of this summer. Please note: new paperwork and medicine is required at the beginning of each school year.

STUDENT FEE BALANCES

There are quite a few Valley View student accounts with outstanding fee balances. Please check your student's account and make any necessary payments. Please note that any remaining unpaid student fee balances from 2023-2024 school year will be rolled over to your student's 2024-2025 balance.
