SAFE MORNING ENTRY INTO SCHOOL

All students should be entering school at the back of the building each morning by their grade level doors. Breakfast students will be allowed to enter at the back of the building starting at 7:45am. The front doors will be opened only from 8:08-8:15 to allow students in. For safety reasons, it is suggested that students are dropped off by 7:50am and walk to the back playground. This will allow for students to have some social interaction with peers and enter with their classroom when the first bell rings. This will also help to alleviate any additional stress of dealing with last minute traffic at the front of school and students making the dash up the front walk into school. STUDENTS LEAVING SCHOOL EARLY

If your child needs to leave school during the day please send an email to vvattendance@ashwaubenonk12.org prior to or the morning of the early release. The email should include:

- the student's full name and teacher
- the time and date they will be picked up
- who will be picking them up
- the reason for leaving

Sending an email will eliminate classroom interruptions and maximize instructional time. Any student leaving during the day must be signed out by an adult. Please note that leaving school before the 3:15 dismissal bell will reflect on the student's attendance record as a tardy early release (TER).



Please help and encourage your children to arrive at school on time. The entry bell rings at 8:08 a.m. Students must be in their classroom ready to work by 8:15 a.m. Students not in their classrooms by this time need to report to the office for a tardy slip. Even a couple of minutes late can be disruptive to the class and the student could miss morning instruction. Teaching our children to arrive on time, even early, is a great life skill. The regular school day runs from 8:15 a.m. - 3:15 p.m.

PLEASE BE REMINDED THAT SINCE PLAYGROUND SUPERVISION DOES NOT START UNTIL 7:45 A.M., STUDENTS SHOULD NOT BE AT SCHOOL BEFORE THAT TIME.

CONSISTENT DAILY AFTER SCHOOL PLAN

We are asking all parents to work as a family to develop a consistent after school plan. A consistent family plan avoids confusion and ensures that students always know how they get home each day. When in doubt, school staff will always dismiss children based on the plan that was communicated to the teacher at the beginning of the school year.

- If a student simply tells his/her teacher he/she is not to ride the bus but wait for a ride, the classroom teacher will place the student on the bus as usual unless this change is communicated to the teacher by the parent.
- If your student typically goes to the Y program after school, we ask that you come into the school and sign your student out with the Y rather than calling into the school office to change after school plans.
- If your child typically takes the bus home, we ask that you pick your child up at the bus stop rather than calling into the school office to change after school plans.
- Due to varying class schedules and the inability to contact classes, messages left with the office after 2pm can not be guaranteed to get to the student by the 3:15 release time.

This is not meant to inconvenience you, but rather to ensure the safety of your child and that we have the correct information of how your child is to get home.
