MORNING PLAYGROUND SUPERVISION

Playground supervision at Valley View starts at 7:45am each morning therefore students **should not be dropped off at school prior to 7:45am**. Students are expected to play on the playground until the first bell rings at 8:08am. Students will line up on the back playground by their grade level door and walk into school as a classroom. All students are expected to be in the classroom by the time the second bell rings at 8:15am. Students arriving after 8:15am must report to front office door for a late slip before reporting to the classroom.

Our breakfast program runs from 7:45am to 8:10am each morning except on days when there is a late start for school. Breakfast students will be allowed in the back doors by playground supervisors starting at 7:45am. **Breakfast students should not enter the building in the front of the school.**
