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ASHWAUBENON ADVANCES TEAM TO DESTINATION IMAGINATION GLOBALS

Ashwaubenon, WI – April 25, 2016 – An Ashwaubenon Destination Imagination (DI) team has earned the right to advance to the Global Tournament in Knoxville, Tennessee. At the State Tourney, held April 16th on the UW-Stevens Point campus, Ashwaubenon School had 16 teams compete. All first, second and third place finishers at State qualify for the Global Tournament which is held on the University of Tennessee campus from May 24 – 28.

The Ashwaubenon team that's moving on to compete at Globals is ***Parkview Middle School's "The Jelly Beans"***. The team consists of Mason Vinoski, Miles Lasee, Peter Steinhoff, Ally Lukens, Lilly Allen, Yasmyn Collins, and is managed Mrs. Cara Steinhoff and Mrs. Janna Alle. They took 3rd place in the Get A Clue Challenge: featuring artistic media and theater arts, technical design/construction, fine arts, theater arts and visual arts.

For the 2015-2016 season, Ashwaubenon Schools had a total of 36 teams participate in the Destination Imagination program. 25 of those teams were in competitive categories. 16 of the 28 advanced to the State Tournament where the top teams from 10 regions across the state showcased their DI challenge solutions in Elementary, Middle, & Secondary levels.

Destination Imagination (DI) is the world's largest co-curricular creative problem solving competitive program that builds student participants' skills related to: creative problem solving, teamwork, leadership, critical thinking, research and inquiry, innovation, science, technical design and construction, playwriting, and oral presentation skills.

In each season and competition, teams need to solve two different kinds of challenges. The "Team Challenge" is one of six competitive problems that the teams work on over several months incorporating research, technical design, and character/script/presentation development. The "Instant Challenge" is a challenge teams are asked to solve in a very short period of time at their tournament. Teams present their solutions to both challenges for score. Teams qualify to earn "place" awards and/or special recognition awards.
