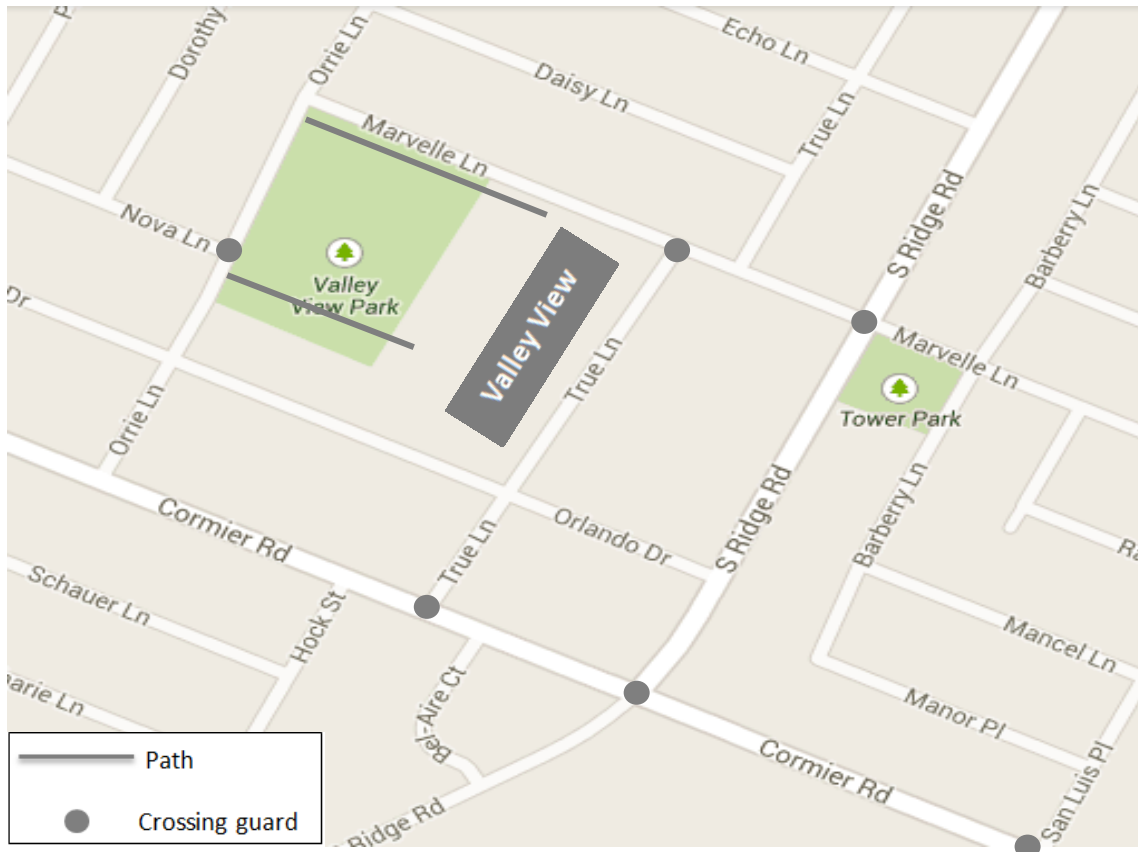
Drop-off & Pick-up Procedures

Thanks to a federal grant administered by the state Department of Transportation's Safe Routes to School Program, Valley View has two new walking and bicycling paths, bicycle racks and a drop-off and pick-up area which will make it easier for students, parents and staff to walk and bicycle to school.

- 1) The original path, from Orrie Lane through the park to behind the school, has been widened and resurfaced and new bicycle racks have been added at the school end of the path.
- 2) A new path has been built from Orrie Lane to along the school side of Marvelle Lane to the school and new bicycle racks have been added at the school end of the path.
- 3) Three landing pads have been added along the Marvelle Lane path where student being driven to and from school should be dropped off and picked up (**No Parking** is permitted on school side of Marvelle Lane).

Note: Students should be dropped off or picked up along the school side (south side) of Marvelle Lane.

Students should not be dropped off or picked up across the street from the school.



Tips for using the paths:

- Walk and bicycle on the right side of the path.
- Go no faster than walking speed.
- Pass on the left and use a bell or say, "Passing on your left".
- Bicyclists must yield to walkers.

When traveling to and from paths:

- Walk on sidewalks or facing traffic.
- Bicycle with traffic (on the right side of road).
- Cross the street only at corners.
- Use crossing guards if available.
- Do not cross the street mid-block.
