WKCE Testing: November 5, 6, and $7^{\text {th }} 3^{\text {rd }}$ grade students at Pioneer will be taking the WKCE (Wisconsin Knowledge and Concepts) Test. This is usually a very intensive test for $3^{\text {rd }}$ graders because they have had no experience with this type of testing before. They will be tested in the areas of Reading and Math. The tests are pretty rigorous for most students.
