



## A Note from our School Nurse...

### **Medication at School**

If your child needs to take prescription medication at school, a medication consent form with both parent and doctor signature is required before the medication can be administered at school. An adult must bring the medication to the office.

If you would like any over-the-counter medications available to your child while at school, an adult must drop off the medication in the original bottle to the office. A medication consent form is needed, but only a parent signature is needed if giving the dose per medication label.
