AHS STUDENTS EARN HONORS AT DISTRCIT SOLO AND ENSEMBLE FESTIVAL

<u>Ashwaubenon, WI – March 11, 2019</u> – The Ashwaubenon High School Music program held their annual Wisconsin State Music Association District Solo and Ensemble Festival this past Friday, at Ashwaubenon High School. There were over 150 instrumental and choral events at the festival.
