Ashwaubenon's Emma Fischer, Samuel Stanko and Christian Van Iten Named Semifinalists in the 2020 National Merit® Scholarship Program

<u>Ashwaubenon, WI – September 11, 2019</u> – Officials of National Merit Scholarship Corporation (NMSC) announced that Ashwaubenon High School students Emma Fischer, Samuel Stanko and Christian Van Iten are among 16,000 Semifinalists in the 65<sup>th</sup> annual National Merit Scholarship Program. These academically talented high school seniors have an opportunity to continue in the competition for some 7,600 National Merit Scholarships worth about \$31 million that will be offered next spring.

From the approximately 16,000 Semifinalists, about 15,000 are expected to advance to the Finalist level, and in February they will be notified of this designation.
