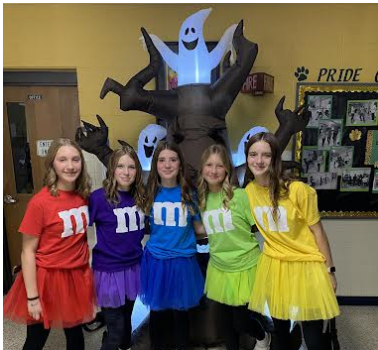
Pioneer Elementary School

New 2-Way Texting Feature

The School District is using a new 2-way communication system called Unified Communications. You might have already received text messages and/or emails from your child's school or teacher. This new tool allows families to communicate back and forth with ASD staff via text and/or email messages. The messages are automatically translated into the parent/guardian's home language. We are excited to use this new platform to better our communication with families.
