Guidance for Students



Daily Health Check



Has the Student...

- Tested positive for COVID-19 in the last 10 days?
- Has been in contact with someone who tested positive for COVID-19 in the last 14 days?
- Developed any of the following new symptoms:
 - cough
 - shortness of breath
 - loss of taste or smell
 - fever of 100.4 or higher

STAY HOME

Call the school office to notify them

New symptoms developed in past 24 hours?

- Sore throat
- Unusual fatigue
- Nausea, vomiting or diarrhea
- Runny nose or nasal congestion
- Headache
- Muscle or body aches

2 or more new symptoms.

STAY HOME

Call the school office to notify them

0-1 new symptoms

Can go to School

Positive Test Result



Student Tests Positive

ISOLATE

Stay home, restrict movement & stay away from those who are healthy

CONTACT

Call the school office to notify them of the positive case

CONTACT TRACE

ASD works with Brown County Health Services to identify persons in close contact with the infected person.

CLOSE CONTACT NOTIFICATION

ASD will notify close contacts with further instructions and quarantine requirements.

When to Return

School

Tested Positive and/or Had Symptoms

ALL 3 have happened

1. At least 10 days have passed since symptoms started
2. No fever in at least 24hrs (without medication)
3. Cough/Breathing problems improve

*Do not need a negative test before returning to school

Close Contacts

ALL have happened

1. At least 10 days have passed since any symptoms started
2. No fever in at least 24hrs (without medication)
3. Cough/Breathing problems improve **PLUS** 14 days have passed since last being in contact with infected person.



You must have permission from school prior to returning

*Situations are can vary from case to case. The district works on cases on an individual basis. Thus, there could be times when procedures are adjusted due to differing circumstances.
