

Registration is by skill level. Each level will incorporate FUN golf games and includes constructive education from HH's Director of Player Development, golf clubs(upon request), use of the practice facility or simulators, range balls, and a daily snack

Junior Level:

- Beginner
- Intermediate
- Advanced

Beginner Level: A beginner junior golfer is typically new to the game and may have limited experience with the swing mechanics. They might struggle with:

- **Basic swing mechanics:** Gripping the club correctly, maintaining a balanced stance, and swinging smoothly.
- **Ball control:** Hitting the ball consistently and controlling its direction.
- Course etiquette: Understanding the rules of golf and proper etiquette on the course.

Intermediate Level: An intermediate junior golfer has a solid foundation in the basics of golf and is starting to develop more advanced skills. They might:

- **Have a consistent swing:** Be able to hit the ball relatively straight and with a decent distance approximately half the time
- **Understand course management:** Be able to strategize their shots based on the layout of the course and their abilities.
- **Be working on improving their short game:** Be focusing on chipping, putting, and pitching.

Advanced Level: The Advanced Golfer is beginning to strategize and plan their shots based on the lie and yardage left for the next shot. This program will implement systems and game management techniques that are used to play at a high level. An advanced junior golfer has a high level of skill and is considering playing at a competitive level. They might:

- Have a powerful and accurate swing: Solid contact a majority of the time and looking for ways to maximize potential distance
- **Be proficient in all aspects of the game:** Have a short game system, be able to manage their emotions on the course, and understand advanced course strategies.
- Be competing in tournaments: Be participating in local or regional junior golf tournaments.
