TITLE: Ashwaubenon Schools Enter Precautionary Lockdown Due to Vague Threats

Ashwaubneon, WI- This morning our agency was notified by Green Bay Police that there were possible threats referencing a school shooting in the Green Bay Area. In these threats Ashwaubenon Schools were allegedly mentioned along with other schools in Brown County.

According to the young people who reported this, the threats were not specific in nature.

Ashwaubenon Public Safety working closely with the Ashwaubenon School District decided to put our school system on lockdown while investigators looked into the origin of the threats. The lockdown lasted for about an hour and was lifted shortly after 11am.

Investigators do not have any specific or credible confirmation of any actual threat or plan, but as a precaution we will have extra police presence in and around our area schools. We remain in close contact with the school district and our neighboring school districts and police agencies and will continue to work closely with all of them to make sure our schools are safe. Anyone with specific information on these or other school related threats is highly encouraged to contact their local law enforcement agency.
