Notes from the School Nurse

Medications at School

If your child will need to take medication at school, a medication administration form is required for ALL medications. Over-the-counter medications that are given as directed per the original bottle need only a parent signature on the form. Prescription medications and over-the-counter medications that are given differently than directed on the original bottle will require both a parent and prescribing physician signature before medication can be given at school, so please plan ahead.

Cold Weather Reminder

Here are some tips to make dressing easier for your children at school!

- Consider purchasing:
 - mittens, not gloves
 - shorter jackets, not longer ones
 - jackets without liners
 - boots without liners or ties
 - snowpants without straps.
- Don't send items that are frustrating for your child to manage. Students want to get out to recess without delay and have fun with their peers!
- Be sure to label snowpants with child's name or initials (they get mixed up with peers at times)




Dear Families,
