Ashwaubenon School District Operational Referendum Information

On April 7, 2020, Ashwaubenon residents will vote on an operational referendum seeking \$730,000 annually for five years starting with the 2020-21 school year and ending with the 2024-2025 school year.



Why Is An Operational Referendum Needed?

Our top priority in the Ashwaubenon School District is to ensure the safety of our students while providing them with a comprehensive PK-12 educational program. The operational referendum would provide:

- Student Mental Wellness Services
- Air Conditioning Operating Costs



How Will Operational Referendum Funds Be Used?

Funds will be used to add the following positions:

- 3 School Counselors
- 2 Social Workers
- 2 Social Emotional Learning Coaches
- 2 Graduation Coaches
- Added Time To Make A Full Time At-Risk Position at the High School

Funds will also be used for:

- Operating Air Conditioning
- Social Emotional Learning Material and Training

It is administered to students in grades 6-12 to examine risk behaviors that can lead to mental and physical health issues. Below are some results for our students from the 2018-19 survey. These results show a need for increased mental wellness support in the district.

52% Parkview students who reported problems with anxiety in the past 12 months
