

RESTORATIVE PRACTICES

Restorative Practices build a school culture that actively invests in relationships among students, staff and the community.



TEACHING COLLABORATION

Students participate with their peers in circles. Circle prompts are based on what is happening in their classroom regarding student behaviors and academics. Every student's voice is heard and class decisions through that lens.

BUILDING PROBLEM SOLVERS

Students learn to reflect on their thinking and how their actions affect others. They problem solve to determine how to run their classroom so that each student feels safe and can focus on learning.



Components

- Circles to build community, engage in academics, solve problems, and repair harm
- Conferences to resolve conflict where victims have a voice and offenders take responsibility for their actions
