What is the Strengthening Families Program?

An evidence-based parent, youth, and family skills-building curriculum that

- Strengthens parent/youth communication skills
- Increases academic success in youth
- Prevents adolescent substance abuse and other problem behaviors

Join us for 6 sessions which includes the following:

- **Free meals** catered from local restaurants.
- **Free childcare** by Ashwaubenon school district staff members for children ages infant to 9 years of age.
- Weekly drawings for **door prizes**.
- Parent sessions include discussions and activities about: what youth this age are like, developing rules and consequences, how to problem solve with youth, various ways to show love and support. The goal is to help support parents with youth preparing for teen years, strengthen family communication, and help youth avoid problems with drugs and alcohol.
- Youth (ages 10-14) sessions include discussions and activities about: resisting peer pressure, handling frustration, and appreciating parents and caregivers.
- Family sessions bring parents and youth together to share things that make your family strong, strategies to solve problems together, and have fun in activities and games.
