Ashwaubenon High School Supermileage Team Wraps Up Season By Hosting Car Show

Ashwaubenon, WI – May 20, 2010 – The Ashwaubenon High School Supermileage Team ended its season on May 10th at the Road America Raceway in Elkhart Lake. The team’s vehicle performed well, achieving an average of 108 miles per gallon and earning first place in braking performance. They wrap up their season by hosting a Car Show, which is also their main fundraiser, on Saturday, May 29th from 10:00am to 2:00pm in back parking lot of Ashwaubenon High.

The Supermileage team has worked long and hard this season to improve on last year’s design. Designers Jake Roes, Richard Hang and Chris Shandor gave the Supermileage vehicle a whole new look. The team received complements from other schools and industry on the car’s body design and its unique drive line.

The team participated in Fox Valley Technical College’s event at Wisconsin International Raceway prior to competing at Road America. The first place finish in braking performance at Road America was piloted by Jimmy VandeLeest, who stopped the vehicle in four feet, ten inches at fifteen miles per hour.

The Supermileage car will be on display at the annual Car Show on May 29th. The show includes a raffle for a 1982 Ford Mustang which will be drawn at 2:00pm. Last year’s show featured over sixty cars and trucks with awards given out in thirteen classes. All types and models of vehicles can register for \$8.00 prior to the show or \$10.00 at the gate. Admission for audience members is \$1.00.
