ASHWAUBENON SCHOOL DISTRICT & THE STOCKED SHELF FOOD PANTRY RECEIVE SCHREIBER FOODS COMMUNITY GRANT

Ashwaubenon, WI – November 10, 2009 – The Ashwaubenon School District, along with its partner The Stocked Shelf Food Pantry, is the recipient of a 2009 Schreiber Foods Community Fund grant, awarded by Schreiber Foods, Inc. The \$2,500 grant will be used to purchase perishable food items for families in the Ashwaubenon School District as well as others who are in need.

The Ashwaubenon School District and The Stocked Shelf Food Pantry formed The Pantry Partnership earlier this year. The school district organizes nine food drives within their schools during the school year. The food collected from these food drives is delivered to The Stocked Shelf Food Pantry, operating out of St. John Lutheran Church in Ashwaubenon. The Stocked Shelf Food Pantry then distributes the collected food, by appointment, to families in need. The Pantry Partnership accepts non-perishable food items, personal hygiene products and monetary donations to purchase perishable food items.

Upcoming food drives are at Pioneer Elementary in November, Valley View Elementary in December, Cormier Early Learning Center and the District Office in January, Parkview Middle School in February, Valley View Elementary in March, Ashwaubenon High in April and Pioneer Elementary in May.

During the fall of 2005, the Schreiber Community Fund was initiated at the Greater Green Bay Community Foundation to allow Green Bay based partners to raise funds to positively impact the community.
