### **TWELVE ASHWAUBENON STUDENTS EARN AP SCHOLAR AWARDS**

**Ashwaubenon, WI – October 2, 2009** – Twelve Ashwaubenon High School students have earned AP Scholar Awards in recognition of their exceptional achievement on Advanced Placement (AP) Exams.

The College Board's AP program provides motivated and academically prepared students with the opportunity to take rigorous college-level courses while still in high school, and to earn college credit, advanced placement, or both for successful performance on the AP Exams. The College Board recognizes several levels of achievement based on students' performance on AP Exams.
