ASHWAUBENON HIGH SCHOOL ATHLETE OF THE YEAR

Criteria: Outstanding athlete who has been involved in multiple varsity sports, is a team leader, and is an exceptional performer. These winners have represented Ashwaubenon High School on the highest stage in their sports. They have been exceptional performers as well as the leaders all programs look for.

Lindsey Strainis (hockey, softball) All-State Hockey Player, 1st Team All-Conference in softball, Hockey State Champion. She is going to continue her playing of both hockey and softball at Marian University. Coach's quote: "Lindsey is not only an outstanding player on the field and ice but has been an exceptional role model for all student-athletes".

Kyle Monroe (football, basketball, baseball). All-State Football and Basketball Player, 1st Team All-Conference in football and basketball. Conference Player of the Year for two years on the hardwood and has a full scholarship to Michigan Tech to continue his basketball career.

James Morgan (football, basketball, track). All-State Football Player, 1st Team All-Conference in football, part of a state-best timed 4x400 relay team that has pursuits of a state championship.
