Four Ashwaubenon High School Students Selected for Wisconsin Honors Music Project

Ashwaubenon, WI – April 14, 2015 – Four Ashwaubenon High School students have been selected to perform in various state Honors groups as part of the Wisconsin Honors Music Project. Altos Jenna Perock and Sophia Jimos will sing in the Honors Treble Choir, bass Benjamin Wright will sing in the Honors Mixed Choir, and Ali Remondini will play percussion in the Honors Band.

Students selected for the Honors program must be a member of their corresponding school music performing group during the spring auditions and fall Honors performance. Judges recommend a placement for each student based solely on the audition performance. A highly recommended student is described as "A potential section leader, and outstanding musician - One of the best!"

The Wisconsin Honors Music Project offers talented youth the opportunity to rehearse and perform with nationally-known conductors in a professional setting. All Honors groups perform at the Wisconsin Music Educators Association (WMEA) State Music Conference in October. High School Honors students sight read their music at a 3-day Summer Camp held on the UW-Green Bay campus and then rehearse again in Madison before the fall concerts.
