Ashwaubenon School District Parents/Guardians and Staff,

As a follow-up to our opt-in text message sent to parents on November 15th and to staff on November 8th, we've come up with additional instructions below in case you haven't yet opted-in or decide to opt-out.

OPT-IN To Receive Our Text Messages

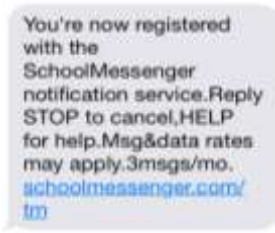
You can opt-in at any time to receive our text messages by:

Texting the word YES or the word SUBSCRIBE to the number 68453 from your cell phone.

You should receive a confirmation text message that you are now registered with SchoolMessenger, our notification service. See example confirmation message on the right.

If you do not receive this confirmation:

1. Contact your cell service provider and have them enable short-code text messaging for your cell phone. If you want to limit who you can send you short-code text messages, allow those messages from the number 68453. *This situation has been most common with Sprint, whose customer service center can be contacted at 844-665-6327.*
2. Try to opt-in again after working with the cell service provider. You may have to reboot your cell phone and/or wait a period of time for their changes from step #1 to take effect.
3. If this still doesn't work, contact your child's school office to make sure your cell phone number is on file with us in PowerSchool.



OPT-OUT From Receiving Our Text Messages

You can opt-out at any time from receiving our text messages by:

Texting the word STOP to the number 68453 from your cell phone on file with us.
