The Child Care Development Fund is now offering an internet assistance program for CCDF categorically eligible families. Eligibility is as follows:

- A household member must be a member of a federally recognized tribe and must live on the Oneida reservation or reside in Brown or Outagamie County
- Must have at least one school aged child between ages 5-12 years old who resides in the home and is attending grades Kindergarten and above (Age guidelines extended for Oneida Immersion program)

Child Care Developmental Fund Application for Internet Assistance

The rapidly evolving COVID-19 pandemic has created unique challenges for everyone, and many families have been impacted financially.

The Child Care Development Fund (CCDF) will be offering internet assistance up to \$75.00 per month to qualifying families who have children attending school virtually. Phone hot spots will NOT be included, and a check will be sent directly to your internet provider for qualified applicants.

Minimum Eligibility Criteria

- *At least one household member must be enrolled in a federally recognized tribe and must live on the Oneida Nation Reservation or reside in Brown or Outagamie county.
- * Child must be between the ages of 5-12 years of age and attending grades Kindergarten or above. (Age guidelines extended for children in the Oneida Immersion Program)
- *Application and required verification must be received by December 31, 2020. **NO EXCEPTIONS**

Applications Requirements:

- _____ Tribal enrollment verification
- _____ Residency Verification (mail postmarked within last 30-days, ex: utility bill, lease)
- _____ Legal/temporary custody verification (if applicable)
- _____ Social Security Number for all household members (list on application)
- _____ Copy of most recent internet provider bill
- _____ Copy of Birth certificate or tribal enrollment card for qualifying child/ren.
- _____ Application must be completed in full, signed and dated.
- _____ Verification of school enrollment (an email from the teacher is acceptable)
